Water, neosporin, radio, first aid, flash lights, cpr mouth barriers, extra clothing, pre-cooked canned food, bandages, gauze, tooth brush and tooth paste, duct tape, lighter and deodorant, rope, splints, fire starters, pocket knife, extra cash,

Poison Control, red cross, fire/police station, friends, CSI, non-emergency number, animal control, anti-terrorism, family, FEMA

Volunteer to help, secure the area, call 911, get them to nearest hospital, perform first aid,

Block up doors, get out of sight, turn off all lights, use cell phones to call for help, first aid, use objects to distract the shooter, scissors as knives, call police and stay on the phone,
