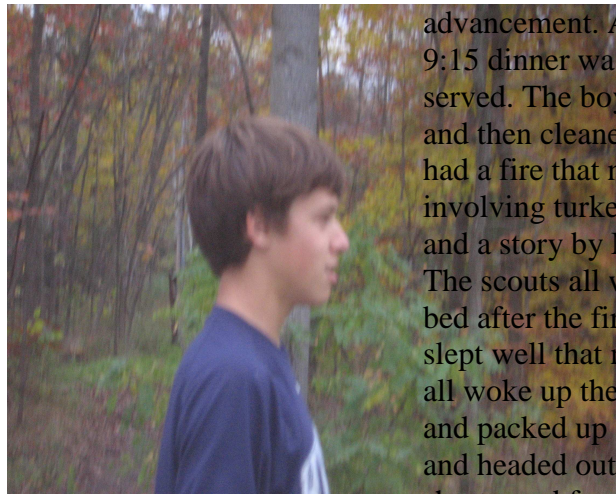


Troop 777 Father Son Campout 10/22/10
